Where Have All the Trees Gone?

A message from our business administrator: Last Saturday, three trees were removed from our campus. The three trees were dead/dying. Each had a lot of dead limbs, the maples had rotted trunks, and the once beautiful ash was dead at the crown, a sign of the ash borer which has claimed most of this species in recent years. In the past year, I had three tree services give us their diagnosis and each said the trees should be removed. If we left the trees to continue decaying in their weakened state, they would present a greater safety concern for our students and staff.

We received a terrific bid to remove the three trees, grind the stumps, and clean up the large oak which had limbs precariously close to the canopy covering the walkway into St. John's Education Center. Doing the work on a warm winter weekend day, with little activity on the parish campus, was the perfect time for

this project. And this gave the students a chance on Wednesday to have fun playing pick-up sticks with Principal Kieffer!

We plan to beautify the areas where the trees were removed. A beautiful large shade tree has already been determined to replace the one in front of the school.
