Dear St. Charles Parents,

Rules & Procedures seem to be everywhere we go. If you choose Catholic education, you can expect that your child's school will have plenty. I've worked with my staff this year on much more communication and clarification around rules. I appreciate the conversations I've had with parents and the partnership you have shown. Even when there is no agreement, there is a united front. I promise you that it is key to the environment WE (parents and staff) are creating, each day for our children.

I want to thank you parents for the response to the communications about pickup and drop off. This morning, we had a clean bus lane, and I'm grateful. Each rule and procedure is a piece of the puzzle, and you clearly support and appreciate what we're doing, otherwise, you wouldn't be reading this ;-)

Here is a funny coincidence! I've pasted a reminder about the pickup line below that is an exact copy of what I sent out exactly 1 year ago at this time! We're on a big wheel folks!

I have a pick-up line request for you, parents, actually two. The first one is to use the pick-up line to pick up your child if you are picking up your child on campus. The kids come out at 2:40, and the line is always gone by 2:50. The supervisors stay out with the kids until 2:55. If you arrive at 2:47, you'll pretty much go right through without any wait. Please use the pick-up line.

The second request is to please make sure that parishioners can get in and out of the parking lot at the Pahl & Roosevelt entrance and exit. When you're turning from Roosevelt into the upper parking lot, please leave room for people heading into or out of the parish parking lot. We are grateful to be able to use the upper lot for our pick-up procedure. Let's make sure the parish business can go on during this time without interruption.

One more thing about the mornings! If your child is going to be getting a school breakfast, please drop them off before 7:30 AM (7:29 is great). This allows enough time to go through the process to receive breakfast. Right now we're being overwhelmed by about 20-25 varying students on any given day, who are walking in at 7:40 AM looking for breakfast. Please adjust the morning routine to help us provide this service to your children. Between 7:20 and 7:30 AM is a great time to drop off kids, the dropoff zone is still very quiet at that time.

Thanksgiving break is coming, and I sense that our community is hungry for family time. There won't be a Weekly Update next Thursday because I'll be in lowa on a couch watching football. The 1st trimester ends on the 26th, and report cards will be made available electronically on December 6th for the first time in St. Charles Borromeo School history! More details will arrive on how to view and print them for those who want a copy for the fridge.

In closing, I would like to express my gratitude to you, our parents, for working together with us to educate and form your children. The staff and I feel blessed to work with your families. Enjoy the family time next week, be safe, and God bless you.
