Dear St. Charles Parents,

It was glorious to have outdoor recess today! As the weather trends warmer, please continue to send your children to school with the proper outdoor apparel.

The teachers and I will have staff development day on February 28th. Please remember there is no school for students that day. The bulk of the day will be spent in Catalyst Approach training which supports classroom instruction and management and is great for supporting our students who have special needs.

Right now we are taking financial aid applications for next year. The Aim Higher application deadline is February 28th. If you plan on applying for financial aid, please submit your application by this date so that your application can be considered for these additional funds! There are limits to the amount of financial aid that St. Charles School can award each year. Aim Higher has provided our students with additional aid for years; we are very grateful for this. Catholic education is a sacrifice for every family, and we want to make it available here for as many children as possible.

I may sound like a broken record but did you know that the first draft of the state budget has cut out nonpublic pupil aid which would directly affect our school, staff, parents, and students? We receive a little state funding, and nonpublic schools provide a very valuable service that saves the state over 100 million dollars per year. We are a strong Catholic community, but we are also a part of the public. We are tax-paying citizens, and our school operates with limited resources.
